Congratulations to Jane McCaffrey, M. D. on receiving the 2006 ATHENA Geneva Award from your friends and colleagues at Finger Lakes Medical Associates.

Dr. Jane McCaffrey began practicing in Geneva in 1973 as the area's first board-certified pediatrician. Tending thousands of children as a solo doctor, she shaped the way colleagues would care for thousands more.

McCaffrey broke with over-the-phone doctoring and required all patients to be diagnosed in person. She started neonatal resuscitation practices in Geneva, and was the first pediatrician there to routinely use intravenous lines, said Lara Chatel Turbide in nominating McCaffrey for this year's ATHENA Award.

McCaffrey pushed forward outpatient care for children and was the first physician in the region to employ a nurse practitioner. In addition, equal health care for all patients is a McCaffrey hallmark. "Dr. Jane McCaffrey has led the way for women in medicine, supported women in our community and enhanced the standard of care provided to all of our children," Turbide said.

In 2002 Dr. McCaffrey became board-certified in developmental behavioral pediatrics after completing a three year Fellowship at the University of Rochester, Strong Memorial Hospital. She also served as Chief of Staff of Geneva General Hospital in 2001 and 2002.

McCaffrey is a mainstay in community groups such as Geneva Head Start, Happiness House and Success for Geneva's Children.

We are pleased to join our community in recognizing and applauding the achievements of this remarkable woman.
